The Corporation is organized to protect and preserve historical sites and landmarks within Sterling County, Texas and to preserve the heritage which created them. The nonprofit corporation organized a Centennial Celebration for the county's 100th birthday in 1991 and provided donations for the renovation of the historic railroad depot for Sterling County Senior Citizens.
