

Taxpayers and members of the public are invited to attend and give input to the Court concerning the budget. The tax rate for the current fiscal year M&O is \$0.449317 per \$100 of value and I&S 0.088576 per \$100 value. The Commissioners' Court has proposed a M&O tax rate of \$0.4594481 per \$100 and I&S 0.00 per \$100 of value to fund the proposed budget. Notice: "This Levy will raise less property tax than last year's Levy by \$971,723, a decrease of 20.86%, and of that amount \$3,875 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year." The Public Hearing will be followed on the same day by a meeting of the Court at 9:00 a.m. to adopt the budget and tax rate for FY2020-21.
